RPI Deficiency is the rarest brain disease in the world, there are only 3 known cases historically, where the patients have what is called diffuse white matter abnormalities. Affecting the deepest and largest parts of the brain, this disease can cause psychomotor regression and progressive developmental delays, with symptoms such as seizures, damage to the eyes, spasticity and a slowing down of emotional and physical reactions.

I. Immune-Mediated Encephalomyelitis. Acute disseminated encephalomyelitis (ADE) is a neurological disorder involving inflammation of the brain and spinal cord. A hallmark of the disorder is damage to the myelin sheath that surrounds the nerve fibers in the brain, which results in the inflammation.

Functional neurologic disorders are related to how the brain functions, rather than damage to the brain's structure (such as from a stroke, multiple sclerosis, infection or injury). Early diagnosis and treatment, especially education about the condition, can help with recovery.

Some of the more common diseases that affect the nervous system include muscular dystrophy (a neurogenetic disease), cerebral palsy (a developmental disorder), Parkinson's disease (a degenerative disease), stroke (a cerebrovascular disease), convulsive disorders, metabolic diseases, infectious diseases, trauma and brain tumors [source: National Institute of Neurological Disorders and Stroke].

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
