Your dialectical journal entries should confirm that you understand what you're reading. Keeping this journal will authenticate that you are engaged with the text. There are two ways to develop your Dialectical Journal: #1: You will first annotate text that seems significant, powerful, thought provoking or puzzling like the following examples:

To Kill a Mockingbird Dialectical Journal

A dialectical journal is another name for a double-entry journal or a reader-response journal. It's a journal that records a dialogue, or conversation, between the ideas in the text (the words being read) and the ideas of the reader (the person who is doing the reading). This is what you must do in your journal: keep a dialogue with yourself.

Language Arts

Dialectical journals are a method of note taking that requires readers to highlight or directly quote passages and then record their emotional responses, opinions and ideas about the passage's meaning. These notes also allow the reader to write personal essays about the material that can be supported by direct quotes.
