6.3.2 Fill Construction. Fill construction is required to cross draws, creeks, flats or swampy areas and when excess excavation has taken place. Road fills support traffic and therefore must withstand considerable abuse. Only mineral soil, free of organic debris such as stumps, tree tops and humus should be used.
